Dear Hedgesville Little League player,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you and your parents about the Hedgesville Little League Baseball and Softball All-Star teams and the commitment it takes to be considered for an All-Star Team. While it is a great honor to be selected as a member of the All-Star team, there is also a <u>substantial commitment of time required</u> in order to participate. You and your parent must complete the attached commitment form, which will indicate your SINCERE INTEREST and AVAILABILITY, to be placed on the voting ballot for All-Stars. Selection to a team is done by a voting process, which involves players and Managers.

For the divisions below, you must have been on a LL roster to be considered. Minor League players are not eligible unless they have been placed on a LL roster during the spring season.

Any HLL player that is League age 10, 11 or 12 is a candidate for the 10/11/12 team.

Any HLL player that is League age 9, 10 or 11 is a candidate for the 9/10/11 team.

Any HLL player that is League age 8, 9 or 10 is a candidate for the 8/9/10 team (8-year old's must be on a LL team roster to be considered).

(League age 11-year olds can and will be considered for the 11/12 team and if chosen, will be placed on the 11/12 roster. If you then decide you do not want to play on an 11/12 team, you will lose any All-Star eligibility and another player will be selected. Please consider this before agreeing to participate in the voting process.)

Eligibility to be considered means a child must meet the age guidelines listed above, residency requirements, and must have participated in at least 8 of the regular spring season games for which they were eligible to play.

Ability of a player is solely the opinion of those voting on the selections.

<u>Availability</u> entails being able to practice and play with the team at scheduled events. There could be daily practice beginning as early as **June 4, 2023**, as well as travel to tournament sites. Winners at the district level will advance to State tournaments. Players are expected to attend **all** practices, games, and fund-raising events, which could last through mid-August.

Should a player desire to be considered and if he/she meets the requirements set forth above, he/she will be placed on the All-Star voting ballot according to League age.

If you are agreeable to all the requirements listed above, please indicate your <u>desire to be placed on the voting</u> <u>ballot</u> on the accompanying form.

If you do not desire to be considered in the voting process, please indicate this on the accompanying form.
